





With in-phase signals (using standard AC lines) quadrants I and III are used.




Figure 1. Typical RMS Current Derating




Figure 2. On-State Power Dissipation




Figure 3. On-State Characteristics

Figure 5. Typical Hold Current Variation




Figure 6. Typical Gate Trigger Current Variation




Figure 7. Typical Gate Trigger Voltage Variation






Figure 8. Simplified Test Circuit to Measure the Critical Rate of Rise of Commutating Current (di/dt)_c
